White Fillings

White fillings, also known as composite fillings, are what dentists use to replace tooth structure that has been destroyed by decay, erosion or due to an accident. These fillings blend flawlessly into your smile, making the dental work relatively unseen.

The high-quality composite material that Passion Family Dental North Lakes uses, is held in place by a very strong bonding system that ensures your filling will adhere directly to your tooth. This process helps to support the remaining tooth structure, lending it strength and support for many years.

If you have old amalgam (silver) fillings, we will keep an eye on them and only replace them when it becomes necessary. However, it is possible to remove amalgam fillings and replace them with new white ones, enabling you eliminate any concerns you may have with having the older fillings in your mouth.

Bad Breath: Causes and Treatment

Bad breath (Halitosis) is caused by bacteria in the mouth and throat that release bad smelling gasses. This bacteria is also responsible for gum disease and tooth decay and builds up because of poor oral hygiene, illness, smoking, dry mouth and medications.
